BETTER RELATIONSHIPS BETTER LEARNING

Our school rule is:

"We show respect to everyone and everything"

Our behaviour in school should reflect this.

In consultation with the children, we have split the school into four teams. Each child is now a member of a team and points can be awarded by any staff member across the week for a pupil showing good behaviour/ making good choices etc. At the end of the week the team with the most points will receive 10 minutes extra playtime on a Friday morning and be at the Top Table for lunch on a Friday.

There is a two tier system for anyone who chooses not to follow our school rule depending on the seriousness of the offence:

- Yellow card given as a warning
- Red card immediate consequence and parents informed either by telephone or letter

These sanctions will be recorded in a behaviour folder and monitored closely for any repeat offenders.
