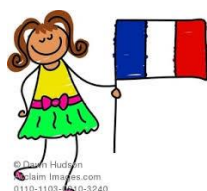
**STAY AND PLAY**

Please note that the next Kingswood trip payment of £60 is due to the school by 30<sup>th</sup> April. Many thanks.

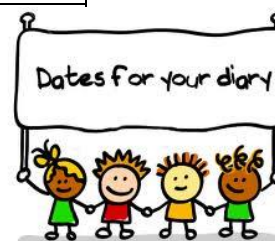
**EMERGENCY CONTACTS**
