Our fingers are crossed that we have a more 'normal' year. ## A few reminders for starting back

- **Please inform us of any changes to contact details throughout the year.**
- **As far as possible, we will continue to have PE lessons outside and won't be getting changed. Joggers, sturdy shoes or trainers will be ideal for this. In addition we ask for each child to have a pair of soft shoes to change into in class and a pair of wellies to stay in school for wet days. If your child cannot yet tie shoe laces, slip ons or Velcro would be recommended. With our unpredictable weather, please ensure your child brings a waterproof jacket every day.**
- **Each child should bring a filled water bottle to school each day. As per SLC policy, these bottles should only be filled with water.**
- **Mindful of Covid restrictions, children should not bring toys to school.**
- **All children from Primary 1 to Primary 4 are now entitled to free school meals. Please check your Parent Pay details are up to date and you are in credit for starting back this week.**
- **Please note that for health and safety, the school car park is only for staff parking and bus drop offs. Parents should continue to drop children off at the pavement**
