- We still have some items of school uniform (polo shirts, sweat shirts, trousers, skirts and jackets) available free of charge. Please pop in to the school and have look. If you have any uniform you no longer need please send in to the school office.
- Each child should bring a filled water bottle to school each day to drink in class. As per SLC policy, these bottles should only be filled with water.
- All children from Primary 1 to Primary 5 are now entitled to free school meals. Please check your Parent Pay details are up to date and you are in credit for starting back this week.
- Please note that for health and safety, the school car park is only for staff parking and bus drop offs. Parents should continue to drop children off at the pavement.
