Each month we will include a staff member reading one of their favourite books. Can you guess who our mystery reader is?



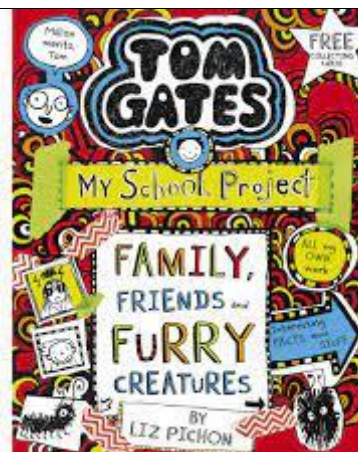
World Book Day
