



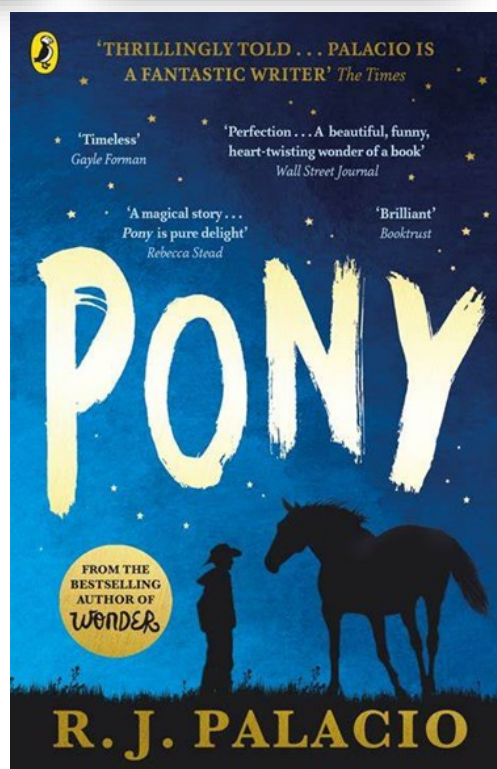

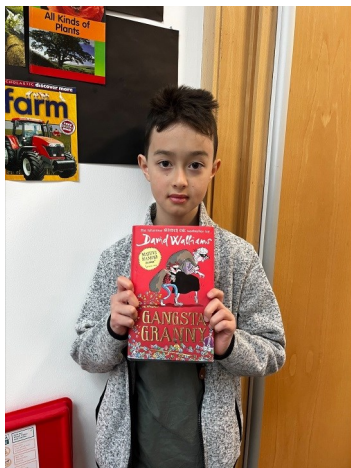
## Guess the Reader

Can you guess who our latest mystery reader is?



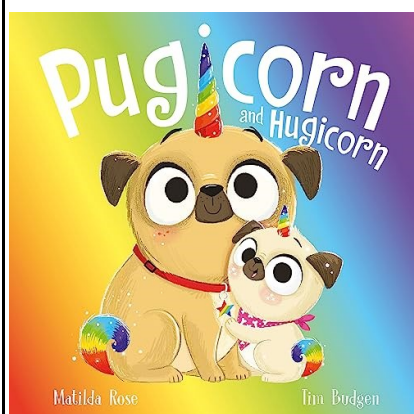
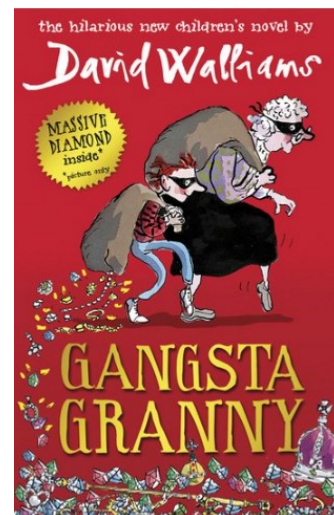
