P1 Enrolment (Added 12Jan21)

As a result of the Covid 19 pandemic, South Lanarkshire Council have revised the infant registration process to make it more accessible to parents online and to avoid parents having to approach the school in person. The new process will be that from 11th January 2021 the online registration form will go live on the SLC website and should be completed by parents for their catchment school. All registrations must be completed by Friday 15th January. Parents will receive a call from the school they have registered with week beginning 18th January to discuss the registration for their child. Please share this message with friends and families who have a child ready to start school in August. Please note that if you are planning to defer your child you will need to register for this year, complete a deferral request and if this is accepted, register for P1 again in January 2022. If you wish to put in a placing request to another school you need to register first for your catchment school informing them of your intention before completing an online placing request form on SLC website. Please do not hesitate to contact the school if you have any queries regarding P1 enrolment.
