#### **Help us with our Playground! (Added 18Feb22)**

As you may be aware, the options for safe play environments for young people in our area are very limited. Currently, the only local play facilities are, the very neglected one at Libberton Village, and Libberton Primary's existing playground which offers insufficient activities for public use. The closest alternative options are the park at Thankerton (2 miles away) and the one at Carnwath (3.4 miles away)

Libberton Primary School's Parent Council would like to invite you to participate in this short questionnaire which could potentially help us to secure funding to enable us to develop our playground into a more useable space for the local community as well as the children at school.

We believe that by providing a safe and attractive play environment within walking distance to our villages and outlying areas, the wellbeing of residents- young and old- will be enhanced. We also recognise that hosting an inclusive and accessible outdoor gathering space will promote community spirit and battle isolation within an area so geographically sparse that it is not always easy for residents of any area to interact with their neighbours.
