UNCRC Article 29: I have the right to an education which develops my personality, talents and abilities

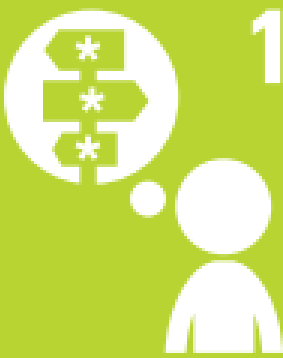
