Welcome to everyone for a new school year and to Mrs Forde our acting head teacher and Mrs Ross as acting principal teacher.

### Head Teacher Report -

It has been a good start to the year and the children have settled in well with the change of staff. Mrs Ross is acting PT and she is working in the P5-7 class with Miss Logan. We are also working on our visions and are asking parents to come into the school and work with staff and the children to work out a whole school vision plan. Wendy happy to do a gardening club and a crochet lunch time club.

P7 residential is booked for one night stay at Broomlee in May next year. It has been asked if the over nights can be increased possibly going on the Wednesday for two nights. Parents felt this is more beneficial to the children. This is unable to happen for this years P7 class but if other schools feel the same, it can be looked at in the future.

# Swimming-

This is going to be a huge cost for the school this year. We are only going to take P6-7 as we can use a smaller bus for transport which reduces the cost considerably. The questionnaire that was

completed by parents has been positive towards a parent's contribution and going for 12 lessons and not 6. If we go for 12 lessons, we only pay for 9 as SLLC cover the cost of the last three. The cost to each P6-7 parent would £5 a session so £45, free school meal kids will have this paid for them through PEF. The parent council agreed to this and have also said they will give the school £500 towards the cost and will look at funding options, if there are any available.

# Fundraising –

It was agreed we would hold a Halloween party in Quothquan hall on Friday the 1<sup>st</sup> November. As this is the first year doing the party we would only have pupils of the school invited. It will be 6-8pm and £1.00 per child and they will get a treat bag with juice, crisps and sweets. This is not being used as a fundraiser but a social event for kids and parents. Parents will be asked to stay and wait at the hall during the party, and we will have tea, coffee and biscuits available. We are going to ask Mandy (Sofia's mum) if she can do the entertainment for the party.

It was also suggested a donations payment for trips etc on ParentPay.

It was agreed we will do the Christmas raffle again this year.
